

Team O'Neil Drift Event Requirements

DRIVER REQUIREMENTS:

- SA 2010 approved helmet. No M or DOT rated helmets allowed
- Long pants, closed toe shoes, shirts required
- Drivers MUST attend morning driver's meeting. Personal driver meetings will not be held. If you know in advance you cannot make the driver's meeting, please make arrangements with a track/event official.
- Be alert, pay attention to all flags and track officials. Failure to do so will result in being sent off track. Multiple offenses will result in ejection.
- Keep pit area clean, use trash receptacles.
- Speed limit for all off-track areas is 5mph. We will enforce a one-way direction in the paddock/garage, building will always be on your left.
- Spills must be cleaned immediately. Water is preferred for cooling systems but coolant will be allowed
- Passengers will be held to same safety standards as drivers. Passenger must provide own SA 2010 or higher rated helmet.
- No passenger will be allowed during tandem sessions without roll cage equipped with door bars.
- No drivers under the age of 18 without parental consent.
- If you go 4 tires off the track, you cannot drive again until speaking with track/event officials. If you are observed not following through on this rule you will no longer be allowed to drive.

CAR REQUIREMENTS:

- No leaks
- No broken wheel studs
- No hanging parts
- Safe and secure seat belts are a must, harnesses must be properly mounted and not expired
- Fire extinguishers are required for all cars, must be securely mounted and within reach of driver while seated with harness on.
- Battery must be securely tied down (no bungee cords, rope, etc)
- Gas tank must be located in factory location. Otherwise a securely mounted fuel cell is required.
- Cars must have a visible tow hook.
